

10602. Ó Corráin (Donnchadh): The stony Vikings of Cell Belaig.

*In* Above and beyond [Swan memorial essays] (2005), pp. 343–349.

Revises the prose narrative appended to the poem *Anbhthine mór ar muig Lir* (Ms Laud 610), interpreting the reference to ‘seven streets of Vikings’ (so K. MEYER, *in* *Otia Merseiana* 2 (1900-1901), pp. 76-83 [IV. Song of the sea], and others) as ‘seven streets there [paved] with *gail*’ (i.e. ‘long stones’).
