

10826. Ó Flaithearta (Mícheál): The etymologies of (Fer) Diad.

In Ulidia 2 (2009), pp. 218–225.

Suggests *diad* in personal name (Fer) Diad derives from gen. **dwi-pod-os* of PIE **dwi-pod-s* ‘two-footed’.
