

11189. McCone (Kim): Léic úait inna biada milsi (Wb. 6^c7): ‘put from you the sweet foods’.

In Sound law and analogy [Fs. Beekes] (1997), pp. 171–175.

Discusses the etymological relationship between OIr. *biad* (< PC **beyatom*) and *biathaid* (< PC **bēlāti*; both ultimately < **√g^weyh₃*- ‘live’), arguing that the difference in root vocalism is due to rule-governed loss of laryngeal in the PC form underlying *biathaid*.
