

11637. McCone (Kim): Gaulish *bussu-*, Irish *bod* ‘penis’, and Sanskrit *buddha* ‘aroused, enlightened’.

In *Ilteangach, ilseiftiúil* [Fs. N. J. A. Williams] (2012), pp. 123–136.

Argues PC **budʷ(d)o-* (> OIr. *bod*) shows a direct reflex of Bartholomae’s Law in Celtic.
