12363. Breatnach (Liam): The lord's share in the profits of justice and a passage in *Cath Maige Tuired*.

*In Celtica* 27 (2013), pp. 1–17.

Offers a new interpretation of §38 (as ed. by E. A. GRAY) based on an analysis of the legal context of this passage, and shows that the characterization of Bres as an oppressive ruler is supported by his unlawful accumulation of clientship dues.

12364. McLaughlin (Roisin): A second source for the text on judges and poets in the pseudo-historical prologue to the *Senchas már*.

Draws attention to a previously unpublished Middle Irish text on pre-Patrician judges and poets in UCD-OFM MS A 9 (transcription and translation provided), and compares it with a version in TCD MS H 3. 17.

12365. Ó Macháin (Pádraig): Three early poems by Fearghal Óg Mac an Bhaird, with notes on the *duanaire* of Domhnall Mac Suibhne.

12366. Ó Riain (Gordon): Early modern technical verse from NLI G 3 (ii).

*Comhardadh cionnas is cóir* (20 qq.), ascr. to Tadhg Ó hUiginn. Critical edition, transcription, translation and notes. In Appendix: *Na ceithre hamharchuill* [on the four graphs beginning with *a* which were recognised in bardic tradition prior to the 15th century].

12367. Ó hUiginn (Ruairí): The Gamhanradh.

Establishes that NLI G 664, acquired from the estate of T. F. O'Rahilly and containing O'Gorman's catalogues of books and manuscripts, was once part of RIA Stowe I v 1.

Argues that three different words [(i) *speilp*, *spailp* 'covering; bout, spell' (> *spailpín*); (ii) *speilp* 'wealth'; (iii) *spalp* 'burst forth'] have been conflated in modern Irish dictionaries under the lemmata *speilp* and *spailp*.
