

1341. Mac Gill'Ìosa (Uilleam): Mo chreach-sa chàinig.

*In* Ramsachadh na Gàidhlig 1 (2002), pp. 45–59.

Argues that *so* replaces *do* as a preverbal particle; evidence mainly from verse texts dated to seventeenth and eighteenth centuries.
