13860. Hayden (Deborah): On the meaning of two medieval Irish medical terms: *derg dásachtach* and *rúad (fh)rasach*.

Argues, based on an analysis of Irish early medical sources, that these terms refer to blood vessels.

13861. Clarke (Michael): The extended prologue of *Togail Troí*: from Adam to the wars of Troy.
