

1522. Harrison (Alan): Lucht na simléirí.

*In* Éigse 15/3 (Samhradh 1974), pp. 189–202.

Satirical text, derivative of *Pairlement Chloinne Tomáis*, containing prose and poetry (a *crossánacht* ?), directed against the Hearth Money Act of 1662. Edited from MSS TCD H 5.9, H 2. 6, RIA 23 K 24, RIA 23 O 79; perhaps composed by Roibeard Nuinsionn. Contains two poems beg. *Ceist agam ort, a Shéamuis* and *Ní dual simeléar ag síol Lóbuis*. Includes a glossary and indexes of proper names.
