

1543. Ó Cróinín (Dáibhí I.): A poem to Toirdhealbhach Luinneach Ó Néill.

*In Éigse* 16/1 (Samhradh 1975), pp. 50–66.

Poem by Muircheartach Ó Cobhthaigh, beg. *Séd fine teisd Thoirrdhealbhaigh*; ed. with Engl transl. from MS NLI G 992 (An Duanaire Nuinseannach). Suggests that poem is was composed for, or shortly after, the poets' convention held at T. L. Ó Néill's court during Christmas 1577; some parallels with Tadhg Dall Ó hUiginn's poem *Nodlaig do-chuamair don Chraoibh*.
