

17437. O'Neill (Pamela): Old Irish *muirchrech* 'sea-boundary'.

*In* *Ériu* 67 (2017), pp. 1–10.

Suggests it is an old compound of *muir* and *chrích*, meaning both 'sea-boundary' and that which is enclosed by it, i.e. 'sea-territory, territorial waters'.
