

1813. Draak (Maartje): Rindard.

A quatrain in praise of *Rúdfolf*, *Iohain*, and *Cúanu*, with (etymological) glosses, composed in 1945 by O. J. BERGIN (recorded by Gerard Murphy, discovered by Maartje Draak) in *rindard*, in reaction to Myles Dillon's criticism of J. Strachan's understanding of this metre. First line *Rúdfolf úasal ecnaid*.
