

2001. Breatnach (Caoimhín): Rawlinson B 502, Lebar Glinne Dá Locha and Saltair na Rann.

*In* Éigse 30 (1997), pp. 109–132.

Argues that *Saltair na Rann* is the old name for the second vellum part of MS Rawlinson B 502, against P. Ó RIAIN's identification of this MS with the lost Book of Glendalough (*in* Éigse 18 (1981), pp. 161-76). Also on the textual history of the Pedigrees of the Saints, and the poems *Druim Ceta Céte na Náem*, *Colum Cille co Dia domerail*, *Táinic sam slán sóer*, *Fuitt co bráth* and *Cia lín don rígraid ráin ruaid*.
