

203. Breeze (Andrew): Gaelic etymologies for Scots *pippane* 'lace', *ron* 'seal', *trachle* 'bedraggle'.

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*Pippane* 'lace, cord' < Gaelic *pípán*; *ron* 'seal' < *rón*; *trachle* 'bedraggle, spoil, weary' < *trochail* 'break down, decay'.
