

2171. Ó Cróinín (Dáibhí): Cummiánus Longus and the iconography of Christ and the apostles in early Irish literature.

*In* Sages, saints and storytellers [Fs. Carney] (1989), pp. 268–279.

Discusses a group of Hiberno-Latin and Irish texts concerning the physical appearance of Christ and the Apostles. Includes the edition of a mixed Latin and Irish text (N<sup>o</sup> 4; from Laud 610) and a wholly Irish text (N<sup>o</sup>5; from Book of Ballymote with variants from NLI G 3); with variant readings and English translation.
