

223. Lindeman (Fredrik Otto): Old Irish *inne*.

In Celtica 23 (1999), pp. 155–156.

Derives from **en-n-iyā* ‘the interior’ from a possible pre-Celtic adjective **en-no-* ‘inner, interior’, from preposition **en* ‘in’ + adjectival suffix **-no-*.
