

224. Mac Eoin (Gearóid): Old Irish *briugu* ‘hospitaller’ and connected words.  
*In Celtica* 23 (1999), pp. 169–173.

Derives Old Irish *briugu* from \**b<sup>h</sup>rg<sup>h</sup>*- ‘high, etc.’ + perfect active suffix \**-uōt-*, meaning ‘having surpassed’, ‘one who has surpassed’.
