Examines the institution of fosterage in early Ireland, focusing on the adoption of Cú Chulainn by Conchobar and the other prominent Ulstermen. Discusses in particular the terms: *gormac*, *dalta*, *nia*, *mac fóesma*, *sét gerta* (or *gairitechta*), *orba niad* and *orba dúthrachta*. Cf. T.
