Discusses the inconsistencies in *Táin bó Cúailnge* (Recension I), and argues that its compiler intended his work to be regarded as historical rather than literary.

2483. McLeod (Wilson): The rhetorical geography of the late medieval Irish chronicles.

*In* CMCS 40 (Winter 2000), pp. 57–68.

Considers the frames of reference for the death-notices of Gaels in the Irish chronicles from the 13th c. onwards, and argues that these should be regarded as fundamentally rhetorical in nature.
