MS TCD H 3. 17, cols 852-55, 864-75 share distinctive features with Laud Misc. 610, ff 59-72r, 123-46, which were written for Séamus mac Séamus Buitillér (†1452), the fourth or 'White' Earl of Ormond. Includes two plates, one from each MS.
