2590. Hamp (Eric P.): Celtic \**dām*- and *v̥ddhi* and δᾶμος.  
*In ZCP* 36 (1978), pp. 5–12.  
Derives OIr. *dám* from PIE \**dom-u-s*, arguing that the long vocalism has been transferred from the strong cases of a hypothetical CC root-noun from PIE \**dom*- and therefore excluding the possibility of *v̥ddhi* derivation. Cf. E. CAMPANILE, in *BBCS* 26/3 (1975), pp. 305-306.
2591. Schmidt (Gernot): Das keltische und das germanische *t*-Praeteritum.  
*In ZCP* 36 (1978), pp. 13–22.  
Argues that the derivation of the OIr. *t*-preterite from a PIE *s*-aorist is impossible, and supports instead the view it spread from a 3sg. resulting from a PIE (non-middle) ending \*-*to* added to the perfect stem.
2592. Lockwood (W. B.): Wortkundliches: [1.] Fünf irische Wieselnamen.

*bean* (or *beainín*) *uasail*, *bláthnaid*, MÍr. *es* (ModIr. *eas*), *flannóg*, MÍr. *íaru* (ModIr. *iora*).
3113. Lockwood (W. B.): Wortkundliches: [2.] *gruag* ‘Haar’, *ceann* ‘Gras’.  
*In ZCP* 36 (1978), pp. 24–25.  
Argues that the borrowings into Norse of these Irish words presuppose a semantic evolution ‘heap’ ~ ‘head’ > ‘hair of the head’ > ‘hair in general’ ~ ‘grass’ already in Old Irish.
3110. Lockwood (W. B.): Wortkundliches: [3.] *rón* ‘Robbe’.  
*In ZCP* 36 (1978), pp. 25–26.  
Argues that this is etymologically identical to *rón* ‘horse hair’; cf. LEIA R-42.

3112. Lockwood (W. B.): Wortkundliches: [5.] Keltische Namen für den Kuckuck.

OIr. *coí*, ModIr. *cuach*, ‘cuckoo’.

 Analyses it as a past participle \**to-ad-naisce* ‘joined to’, cf. *ad-naisc*.
3168. Henry (P. L.): Interpreting *Críth gablach*: 3. *aire cosring*.

 Takes *con-srenga*, *coisreng* in *CG* line 277 as the equivalents of Lat. *contrahit*, *contractus* ‘makes a contract, contract’.

*In ZCP 36 (1978)*, pp. 63–82.  
 Provides transcripts of two fragmentary texts from MS RIA D. iv. 1 (b), namely (A) a story concerning Suithchern, daughter of Áed Bennáin, and (B) the two last episodes of the Munster version of *Imtheachta na nÓinmhideadh*. With English translation.
2595. Meid (Wolfgang): The Yellow Book of Lecan version of *Táin bó Fraích*.

 Diplomatic text from YBL, cols. 649.47–658.41.
2596. Lehmann (Ruth P. M.): Guaire and Marbán.  
*In ZCP 36 (1978)*, pp. 96–111.  
 Offers a new translation of the ‘King and hermit’ poem, based on the text provided by G. Murphy (*BILL* III: 5672).
2597. Ó Briain (Felim), Mac Donncha (Frederic) (ed.): Brigitana.

 Studies the structure and interdependence of the different versions of the *Life of St. Brigit*. Sections: 1. The relation of Broccán’s Hymn to the *Vita Brigitae*; 2. The priority of VA (*Vita Anonyma*) or VC (*Vita Cogitosi*)?; 3. The conflate nature of VA; 4. Sources of VA; 5. Literary borrowings by Cogitosus; 6.
