

2532. Poppe (Erich): A Virgilian model for *lúirech thredúalach*?

*In Ériu* 54 (2004), pp. 171–177.

Suggests that OIr. *lúirech thredúalach* is calqued on the rare Latin collocation *lōrīca trilīx* (*Aeneid* 3×), hence the abundant examples in Middle Irish literature.
