2762. Kalygin (Viktor): Some archaic elements of Celtic cosmology.

Studies the semantics of Celt. **dubno-*, **alb̥no-* and **bitu-* (cf. OIr. *bith*, *domun*, *Alba*), suggesting that the use of these terms reflect an older religious idea of a dual universe composed of white and dark parts.
2763. Zeidler (Jürgen): On the etymology of *Grannus*.

Rejects the connection with OIr. *grend* ‘beard’.
2764. Mikhailova (Tatiana), Nikolaeva (Natalia): The denotations of death in Goidelic: to the question of Celtic eschatological conceptions.

Studies the etymology and semantics of Irish expressions denoting ‘death’ as occurring in the texts, with the aim of retrieving the Celtic attitudes towards death.
