

2623. Wagner (H.): Old Irish *-bria*, subjunctive of *bronnaid* ‘injures, damages, spoils, breaks’.

*In* ZCP 39 (1982), pp. 83–85.

Argues that OIr. *-bria* (*GOI* §610) is the  $\bar{a}$ -subjunctive of an old *\*brenaid* < CC *\*brinati* (cf. Skt. *bhr̥ṇāti* ‘cuts up, crushes’).
