

2821. Ní Chatháin (Próinséas): A linguistic archaism in the *Dúil Laithne*.
In ZCP 49–50 (1997), pp. 610–614.

Claims that in this glossary archaic Ir. *-ch* ‘and’ was used to join the Ogham value of an initial letter with the remainder of its word; vs. R. THURNEYSEN, *Du langage secret dit Ogham*, *in* RC 7 (1886), pp. 369-374 (Best¹, p. 51).
