

2920. Fleuriot (Léon): *Varia*: 1. Le “saint” breton *Winniau* et le pénitentiel dit “de *Finnian*”?

Argues that *Uinniau* (later Gaelicized as ‘Finnian’) was a Brittonic saint established in Ireland.
