

2975. Campanile (Enrico): Note sur vieil-irlandais *bronnaid* (une nouvelle concordance lexicale entre celtique et indo-iranien).

In ÉtC 19 (1982), pp. 151–154.

Argues that OIr. *-bria* (subjunctive to *bronnaid*) is a suppletive form connected to unattested **brenaid*, which can be reconstructed with the aid of Indo-Iranian from a PIE nasal present **b^hri-n-eH-ti*.
