

3156. Kortlandt (Frederik): Old Irish *ol* 'inquit'.

*In* *ÉtC* 32 (1996), pp. 143–145.

Argues that the Old Irish verba dicendi *ol*, *olse*, etc. were originally deuterotonic verb forms with a zero root.
