

330. Corthals (Johan): On a use of *gaibid*.

*In* *Celtica* 14 (1981), pp. 64–66.

*gaibid*, meaning ‘provides for’, in phrases of structure: *gaibid* + object (‘a fixed day’) + indirect object. Discusses use in LU version of *Táin bó Flidais* (see *LU* ll. 1631-32).
