

3689. Lindeman (Fredrik Otto): Celtic \**nāmant-*.

*In* ZCP 55 (2006), pp. 18–24.

Discusses the etymology of OIr. *námae*, arguing that it is a substantivized present participle of a Celtic factitive verb \**nāmā-ti* ‘puts (someone) in a state of fear’.
