

3750. O’Rahilly (Cecile): *Varia*: 2. *is ann : is amlaid*.

*In Celtica* 12 (1977), pp. 188–191.

Traces the West Munster Irish (and Scottish Gaelic) emphasizing use of *is ann*... ‘in (actual) fact’ (= *is amhlaidh*...) back to Middle Irish.
