1. Old Irish *Dagdae* < Celtic **dago-dēuo-* ‘good god’ ~ Slavic **Dažьbogъ*; 2. Old Irish *Macha* < Celtic **Makasiā* ~ Slavic **Mokošь*; 3. Middle Welsh *Pwyll*, lit. ‘wisdom’ < Celtic **k^weislo-* ~ Old Czech *Premysl* ~ *Primizl*; 4. Gaulish *ratet* ‘he pledges, promises, guarantees’, Old Irish *ráth* ‘surety, guarantor, suretyship; guarantee, pledge’ ~ Slavic **rota* ‘oath’.
