

433. Lindeman (Fredrik Otto): Notes on some Milan glosses.

I. On the regular phonetic development of the cluster *ǰg* in the perfect form *do-rubidc*, *do-robidc* (< *do-bidci*; Ml. 40d9, Ml. 58c3), where *rg* might be expected in the unstressed position; II. On the interpretation of *connuargab* (Ml. 37b15) as a nasalising relative clause *con n-uargab*; III. for *innatrachtadaib* (Ml. 35b22), read *innatrachtaib* as in MS; IV. for *dumchoscaibse*, read *du-m-inchoscaib-se* (dat. pl. of *inchosc* ‘instruction’).
