

4427. Breeze (Andrew): Etymological notes on Kirkcaldy, *jockteleg* 'knife', *kiaugh* 'trouble', *striffen* 'membrane' and *cow* 'hobgolin'.

*In* ScotL 16 (1997), pp. 97–110.

Suggests Scots *kiaugh*, *striffen*, are Gaelic loan words (< *ciach*, *srebann*).
