4674. Corthals (Johan): Why did Fergus rise from his grave?

Discusses the *roscad* passage found in *Do fáillsigud Tána bó Cúalnge* (cf. *LL* 32888-32890), which is compared to Fergus's *roscad* in *TBC 1* 1069-1073.

4676. Rodway (Simon): ‘Gaulish’ megaliths in Ireland? *Gall* in *Sanas Cormaic*.

Argues that Cormac's derivation of OIr. *gall* ‘standing stone’ (*Corm.* Y 683) < *Gall* (= L *Gallus*) is unfounded and criticises the view that this entry provides evidence for an Irish tradition of Gaulish settlement in Ireland.
