

5900. Meek (Donald E.): The Scottish tradition of Fian ballads in the middle ages.

*In* Unity in diversity (2004), pp. 9–23.

Surveys the corpus of Fenian lays in the Book of the Dean of Lismore, and argues in favour of the emergence of a distinctively Scottish ballad tradition, ultimately caused by the demise of the Lordship of the Isles (1493).
