

632. Mc Manus (Damian): *Úaim do rinn*: linking alliteration or a lost *dúnad*?
In *Ériu* 46 (1995), pp. 59–63.

Discusses meaning of *úaim do rinn* as it occurs in the introduction to *MV II* (p. 29 as ed. by R. THURNEYSEN 1891 [Best¹, p. 53]) and in the poem *Dúnta for ndúan décid lib*. Concludes that it is a type of *dúnadh*, whereby the link is to the end of the first line, i.e. the whole of the first line is repeated.
