Studies the organization of the king's banquet as described in *Suidigud Tigi Midchúarta*, discussing in particular the carving sequence and the hierarchically distributed cuts of meat: 1. *lónchrúachait*; 2. *leschrúachait*; 3. *loarg*; 4. *muc formuín*; 5. *colpthae*; 6. *crúachait medóin*; 7. *cunn*; 8. *mael*; 9. *midimir*; 10. *milgetan*; 11. *camchnáim*; 12. *colpthae muc*; 13. *remor n-imdae*; 14. *dronn*.
