

8579. Breeze (Andrew): A Brittonic etymology for Old English *stor* 'incense'.
In Anglia 116/2 (1998), pp. 227–230.

Rejects Max FÖRSTER's view (*in Englische Studien* 70 (1935), pp. 49-54) that this is an Irish loan word.
