

9753. McCone (Kim): Old Irish *do-uccai*, *do-ratai*.

In GS Schindler (1999), pp. 355–364.

Argues that *do-uccai* derives from an old causative $*h_{2/3}\bar{o}nk\text{-}ye/o\text{-}$ to the PIE ‘Narten’ present $*h_{2/3}\acute{e}nk\text{-}ti$, $*h_{2/3}\acute{e}nk\text{-}\eta ti$, and that *do-ratai* is an old primary verb (< $*deh_3\text{-}$ ‘give’) absorbed into the weak *a*-class.
