2658. Testen (D.): Palatalization and the Irish \bar{a} -stem.

In ZCP 41 (1986), pp. 272–279.

Argues that the declension of the oblique cases of the OIr. \bar{a} -stems can be derived regularly from Indo-European with the intervention of the analogical spread to the nominal inflection of an extended stem in *-*osiā*- based on the forms here postulated for the accusative, genitive and dative of the 3rd sg. fem. demonstrative pronoun.

3668. Falileyev (Alexander): Father of muse and son of inspiration.

Discusses OIr. *mac uad* (*Corm.* Y 599) and its relationship to *W tad awen* (in Talhaearn's epithet *Tat Aguen*).
