Surveys eight publications by Christian MATRAS (1900-1988) on Irish loan words in Faeroese, focusing particularly on the loans from *dronn*, *bláthach*, **slabac*, *dais*, *cró*, *tarb*, ScG *lámh chearr* (< OIr. **lám cherr*), *muirean* (or *muirín*, *muiríneach*, etc.), *sopp*, *áirge*.
