2815. Mac Eoin (Gearóid): The *briugu* in early Irish society.

In ZCP 49–50 (1997), pp. 482–493.

Discusses the term *briugu* and the process of promotion from the freemen grades to the noble grades according to early Irish law, and also argues, based on an analysis of their property qualifications and their moral character, that the *briugu* of *Uraicecht becc* and the *mruigfer* of *Críth gablach* (complemented by the *fer fothlai*) are variant designations of the same rank.
