11698. Ó hUiginn (Ruairí): *Cond-ricc*, *cond-ránic* srl.

*In Féilscribhinn do Chathal Ó Háinle* (2012), pp. 641–650.

Studies the alternation between *con-* and *cond-* in forms of *con-ric* (some analysable as *ro-icc* preceded by relative *con-* or the conjunction *co<sup>N</sup>*), and argues that the *-d-* in these forms is not a pronominal but the result of anaptyxis.
